Total IDA-\$2L College Funds

Is your adjusted gross income \$25,760 or less per year for a household of one (add \$9,080 for each additional person in your household)? Is your household net-worth \$10,000 or less, excluding a vehicle and/or home if you own either? Are you a Coconino County Resident, and have a driver's license or other government issued photo ID? If yes to all, you may be eligible to enroll for a Coconino County Individual Development Accounts (IDA) \$ave2Learn (\$2L) post-secondary education grant matching 3:1 up to \$1,000 of your saved earned income. This can turn your \$1,000 into \$4,000 to cover certificate or degree related tuition, fees, books, and supplies per your class syllabi.
